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# ENNIS – The Centre of the West of Ireland

#### INTRODUCTION

This socio-economic profile offers a comprehensive overview of Ennis, drawing from the latest data available from the Central Statistics Office (CSO) Census 2022. It provides a detailed analysis and visualisation of the town's demographic, social and economic characteristics through a range of charts, graphics and accompanying headline commentary.

The profile compares the town's performance with national and regional towns of similar size (across Ireland and in the West of Ireland), and then provides further detail at a local level across Ennis. This local level analysis provides, for the first time, a unique profile of ten neighbourhoods across the settlement boundary in areas such as Lifford, Clonroadmore and Roslevan.

Additionally, the profile includes data on a one-hour drive-time catchment from the

town - highlighting the town's potential for future investment and providing a broader view of the catchment's socio-economic conditions to assist current and future employers and investors gain insights into the local and regional labour market - including skill and education levels, employment rates and commuting patterns.

The purpose of this document is to provide a solid evidence base to support future decision-making within Ennis. It is designed to serve a diverse audience, including:

- Businesses: Entrepreneurs and companies can leverage this data to understand the local and regional market, identify opportunities for growth, and make informed investment decisions.
- Local Community Groups: Organisations can utilise this profile to advocate for resources, plan community projects, and address local needs effectively.



- Students and Researchers: Academics and students can use the data for research purposes, contributing to a deeper understanding of Ennis's socioeconomic landscape.
- The General Public: Residents and interested parties can gain insights into the town's development and engage meaningfully with their community in a more informed manner.

By providing a clear and detailed profile of Ennis's current socio-economic status, this document aims to assist stakeholders in making well-informed decisions, promoting sustainable growth, and attracting new investment to the town.

# A Socio-Economic Profile, 2022


#### **ABOUT THIS PROFILE**

This socio-economic profile is based primarily on the results from Census 2022 which was enumerated by the Central Statistics Office (CSO) on Sunday, 3rd April 2022. The Census data is supplemented by additional datasets on jobs profiles, house prices, rental prices, and educational flows.

For the purposes of this profile, the town of Ennis is based on the official CSO boundary of the town (Built-up Urban Area - see map) - an area of 23.1 square kilometers with a recorded population of 27,923 in Census 2022. The 'built-up urban area' boundary covers all of the residential parts of Ennis from Woodstock and Woodlawn to the west, Roslevan to the east (as far as the motorway junction), Ballyalla/Ballymaley to the north, and finally, the entirety of the village of Clarecastle to the south.

The data in the profile is set out across three themes - Demographics, Society and Economy with each theme providing a range of indicators that detail the position of Ennis town at a set of comparative geographical scales:

- A bottom-up comparison with figures for the Ennis Municipal District, County Clare, the Mid-West and Southern Regional Assembly and the State;
- A top-down comparison of Ennis with the ten local neighbourhood areas within the town. The neighbourhood areas are based on aggregations of Census Small Area boundaries (local Census areas of approx 75 households) that closely align with the





Ennis neighbourhood boundaries as set out within the Ennis Municipal District - Clare County Development Plan 2023-29. The ten neighbourhoods are: Ballybeg/Clarecastle, Ballycorey/Ballymaley, Cahircalla More, Claureen, Clonroadbeg, Clonroadmore, Cloughleigh/Drumbiggle, Lifford, Roslevan and Woodstock.

A comparison of the town of Ennis with similar sized settlements in Ireland (>10,000 population). Comparing Ennis with other similar-sized towns allows for a relative assessment of its performance across various socio-economic indicators. By demonstrating how Ennis compares favorably with other towns, it becomes easier to position Ennis as an attractive location for potential investors. The analysis benchmarks Ennis with two classifications of towns - (1) all those in Ireland with a

population >10,000 (excluding city region towns such as Swords, Carrigaline, Bray i.e., already forming part of an economic sphere of a city) (n=41) and (2) all towns in the West of Ireland with a population > 10,000 stretching from Donegal to Cork (n=9).

The profile also provides data on the drive-time catchment from Ennis (1-hour, population = >575k). This is important as potential investors need to know the size and characteristics of the available population and labour force within a reasonable commute. This includes data on educational levels, skill sets and employment rates and positions Ennis as the centre of the West of Ireland.



- According to Census 2022, the number of people residing within Ennis was 27,923. This is equivalent to 21.8% of County Clare (128k).
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis is the 4th largest town with only a larger population in the eastern towns of Navan (33,886), Dundalk (43,112) and Drogheda (44,135).
- Ennis is the largest town in the West of Ireland with Tralee (26,079) the only other town with a population above 25k.
  - Within a 1-hour drive-time from Ennis there is a population of >575k. This is a larger 1-hour population catchment than both Galway City (494k) and Limerick City (541k).





- The population in Ennis has increased on a continual basis from the 1970's up to today with the population in the town recorded at 27.923 in 2022.
- The major period of growth, as per national trends, took place from the late nineties onwards and coincided with large scale residential developments in areas on the periphery of the town - Gort Road (Ard Caoin), Roslevan (An Sean Dún, Gort na mBlath, Cappagh Lawn), Lahinch Road and Woodstock (Garrán na Coille, Ros na Rí, Moyard) and the Limerick Road/Clarecastle (The Hawthorns, Inis Cláir).
- High levels of natural increase (births minus deaths) and significant levels of inward international migration (post 2004 EU enlargement) have been key factors in expanding the population in Ennis.





- According to Census 2022, the number of young persons (0-24 years) residing within Ennis was 8,819 and this represents 31.6% of the population of the town. This rate is marginally below the State average (32.2%).
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 6th highest number of young people and the highest number in West of Ireland towns.
- There are >187k young persons living within a 1-hour drive-time of Ennis.
- Across the Ennis neighbourhoods, there is a quite a variation with highest rates in Woodstock (40.5%), Roslevan (38.2%) and Claureen (37%).
  - The average age in Ennis is 38.9 years.



- According to Census 2022, the number of persons aged 15-64 (Working Age) residing within Ennis was 18,228 and this represents 65.3% of the population of the town. This rate is equal to the State average (65.3%).
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 5th highest number of working age persons and the highest number in West of Ireland towns.
- There are >375k working age persons living within a 1-hour drive-time of Ennis.





- According to Census 2022, the number of persons aged 65+ residing within Ennis was 4,073 and this represents 14.6% of the population of the town. This rate is lower than the State average (15.1%).
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 4th highest number of persons aged 65+ and the 2nd highest number in West of Ireland towns.
- There are >89k persons aged 65+ living within a 1-hour drive-time of Ennis.
- Across the Ennis neighbourhoods, there is a lot of variation with highest rates in Cahircalla More (28.8%) and Clonroadbeg (21.4%). In contrast, lowest rates are in Roslevan (8%).







- Ennis has four post-Primary schools with a total student population of 3,432 comprising of 1,800 girls (52%) and 1,632 boys (48%) (Department of Education 2023/24). Ennis post-primary students account for 37% of all students in Clare schools (9,350).
- Pupil numbers are as follows: St Flannan's (1,200 - the 14th largest school in the State), Coláiste Mhuire (988 - 4th largest all-girls school in the State), Rice College (668) and Ennis Community School (576).
- On average, approximately 90% of Ennis Leaving Certificate students progress to 3rd level education with the most popular destination being the University of Limerick (30%), Technological University Shannon (18%), University of Galway (18%), Mary Immaculate (9%) and Atlantic Technological University (9%)







- According to Census 2022, the number of persons aged 15+ in the labour force (at work and unemployed) in Ennis was 13,727. This is equivalent to a labour force participation rate of 61.6% - similar to the State average.
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 4th highest labour force and the highest number in West of Ireland towns.



- According to Census 2022, there are 1,323 people living in Ennis town who are unemployed. This is equivalent to 9.6% of the labour force. The rate in Ennis is marginally below that of the State (91.7%) and Clare (91.9%) averages.
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 9th highest number of persons unemployed and the 2nd highest number in West of Ireland towns.
- Within the neighbourhoods, highest rates are in Cloughleigh/Drumbiggle (15.1%) and Clonroadbeg (13.3%).
- Latest data from the CSO (May 2024) details that there are 2,128 persons registered for unemployment benefits at the Ennis INTREO Centre - including 219 under the age of 25.








- According to Census 2022, the number of occupied households in Ennis that are owner occupied with a mortgage was 2,906 This is equivalent to a rate of 27.4% of all occupied households - marginally lower than the Clare average of 28.4%.
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 8th highest number of households that are owner occupied with a mortgage and the highest number in West of Ireland towns.
- Across Ennis neighbourhoods, highest rates are in areas where developments over the last two decades have been most prominent - Roslevan (42.9%), Woodstock (39.1% and Ballybeg/ Clarecastle (38.8%).


# Residential Property Sales Prices, 2024

- According to data from the CSO Residential Property Price Index, the rolling 12 month mean sales price for residential properties in Ireland was €380k.
- Over the same period, the mean sales price in Ennis (V95 Eircode routing key area) was €272k. This figure is only 71.5% of the mean value of sales in the State. Since April 2021, annual mean sales values in Ennis have increased by more than a quarter (+27% or +€58k).
- Across the various buyer types, first-time buyers (€274k) paid less than former owner occupiers (€289k).
- Residential sales prices vary greatly across the country with prices in large parts of the west of Ireland much lower than eastern counties. For instance, the mean annual sales price in Clare (April 2024) was €260k whereas the value in Kildare was €400k.
- Relative to other large towns in the West of Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 3rd highest mean annual sales value.


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

- According to Census 2022, the number of occupied households in Ennis that are rented privately was 2,282. This is equivalent to a rate of 21.6% of all occupied households - much higher than the Clare average of 13.9%.
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 9th highest number of households that are rented privately and the 4th highest number in West of Ireland towns (2nd lowest rate - 9th of 9).
- Across Ennis neighbourhoods, highest rates are in central Ennis neighbourhoods where over a quarter of properties are privately rented -Clonroadbeg (27.5%), Clonroadmore (26.6% and Lifford (25.9%).


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




- According to Census 2022, the number of occupied households in Ennis that are classed as social housing (rented from the local authority or voluntary body) was 1,311 (12.4%). This is equivalent to a rate of 12.4% of all occupied households - much higher than the Clare average of 7.5%.



  Relevant to other counties, Clare had the
  11th lowest monthly rental price at €912
   approximately half of the rental price in
  Dublin.
- The average monthly rental price for Ennis town (all property types, all bedrooms) was recorded at €989 in Q3 2023. Since 2016, the average rental price in Ennis has increased by +64% or +€389 per month. This rate of increase is similar to that in Clare (+65%).
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions),
   Ennis has the 3rd least expensive monthly rent.
- The average rent in Ennis is only 60% of the average rental price in many large towns in the east of the country.




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

- According to Census 2022, a total of 385 households were built in Ennis in the period from 2016 to 2022 - this is equivalent to 3.6% of the total housing stock in the town (10,695).
- Relative to other large towns in Ireland (>10,000 pop and outside city regions), Ennis has the 26th highest number of new homes since 2016. Much of the major growth has occurred in towns in the east of the country. However, growth in Ennis has been highest amongst West of Ireland towns.
- Many of the new developments between 2016 and 2022 have occurred in the Ballybeg/ Clarecastle (149), Roslevan (64) and Cahircalla More (48) neighbourhoods.
